1. RULES: The regatta will be governed by the Racing Rules of Sailing (RRS) 2009-20012, the prescriptions of US Sailing, the ISSA Procedural Rules, the PCISA Supplemental Rules, the rules of the CFJ class; and this Notice of Race (except as any of these are changed by the Sailing Instructions); and by these Sailing Instructions

2. ELIGIBILITY, ENTRY & ENTRY FEE, REGISTRATION

2.1 This regatta is open to all High School Teams

Teams may enter by filing an entry with Cal Maritime using the accompanying Entry form, by **Jan 28, 2009**. Entry fee may be paid on regatta day.

2.2 Entry Fee: The entry fee is \$25.00 per competitor, Make checks payable to CMA. Fee will include Continental Breakfast, Bag Lunch and refreshments after sailing.

2.3 Schools may enter as many teams as they chose. If your school does not have sufficient sailors to form the necessary teams, we will attempt to "mix and match" sailors from different schools. If your school has more than one team please use a separate entry form and label them as team 1, 2, 3 etc.

3. BOATS:

3.1 Each entered team is responsible for providing one class legal CFJ and one class legal set of sails (main and jib). Boats are available for charter. There will be no formal rotations.

3.2 EACH SAIL SHALL HAVE A UNIQUE SAIL NUMBER INCLUDING YACHT CLUB/ SCHOOL/ ORGANIZATION examples: CMA 1, RYC 3, PYSF 2.

3.3 It is the intent to have A&B divisions START separately.

3.4 After two races, time will be allowed (determined by RC) for those who wish to substitute in. This will be done on the water.

4. SCHEDULE OF EVENTS

4.1 Registration & boat check-in: 8:00 **DO NOT STEP MAST UNTIL BOAT IS ON THE DOCK.**

5. SAILING INSTRUCTIONS: Will be available at the competitors meeting

7. SCORING

7.1 The low point scoring system, rule A2, will apply, with one full rotation scheduled of which three races must be completed to constitute a series. Each team score will be the sum of the "A" & "B" scores in all races.

8. TROPHIES

8.1 There will be trophies for the top three teams.

9. LUNCH Lunch will be provided on the water for competitors. The Dining Hall will be serving brunch until 12:30 for coaches & spectators. The cost is \$6.75.
